Cotton or leather shop apron

Safety glasses

Jewelers saw frame

Saw blades (sizes 2/0 and 4/0)

Beeswax or small wax candle

Jeweler's needle file set (12 file set, medium cut)

Jeweler's pliers... flat-nose, chain-nose, round-nose (all smooth jaws) and side cutters (flush cut preferred)

12" metal ruler

1/2" x 3 5/8" riveting hammer

1 1/2" yellow plastic mallet

4" x 4" x 1" steel bench block

Pointed metal scribe

Toothbrush

Jewelry polishing cloth (rouge cloth)
