Materials List

Acrylic Paint: Either small tube or fluid colors work very well. Small bottles are fine.

Cadmium Yellow Light, Quinacridone Magenta or Crimson, and Ultramarine Blue or Phthalo Blue, any Black and White and Colors you like

Matte Medium: 1 pint

Brushes:

One 1-inch Flat Brush

Two round brushes in sizes around #8 and # 12

1½" or 2" foam or inexpensive bristle brush

Disposable Painting Palette (10x12" or larger, Styrofoam/plastic plates will work)

Two Canvases (8x10" pre-stretched or piece of cardboard, other surfaces will be discussed in class)

Small Water Spray Bottle (Target/Walmart sell these in the department where you purchase travel-size products)

Scissors

Paper Towels / Rags

Water Container (32 oz. plastic containers work well, i.e. yogurt containers)

Two Inexpensive Plastic Table Covers (Dollar Store)

Different Types of Papers to Use for Collage (ephemera, tickets, photos, mail scraps, card stock, scrapbooking papers, magazine pictures, wrapping papers, stationary, maps, song sheets, etc.)

Color Wheel

Optional- Rubber Stamps you like
